Dear Parents,

I am writing to remind you of steps that you are asked to take to help control HEAD LICE among our students.

- Please check your student(s) for head lice at home.
- If you find that your child has been infested with lice, inform the nurse's office (792-2146) so that possible contacts may be checked.
- If your child is found to be infested while in school, you will be asked to take your child home, treat your child and clean bedding, clothing etc.
- After your child has been treated, you are asked to bring him/her to the nurse's office to be rechecked before returning to classrooms. Children will also be rechecked at a later date if indicated.
- Remind your child not to share hats, combs and brushes with others..
