

Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am writing in compliance with provisions of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 to inform you that, because your child's school receive Title I federal funding, you have the **right** to request information regarding the professional qualification of your child's classroom teacher(s).

Specifically included is your **right to know** the following:

Whether the teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;

•

Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived;

•

The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and filed of discipline of the certification or degree;  
and

•

Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualification.

Should you wish to exercise your **right** to obtain the above information about your child's teacher please contact the office of the Superintendent of Schools in writing at the following address to make your request.
